

Graduate Teaching and Research Assistantships – The University of Texas A&M, Qatar

The Chemical Engineering Program has available a number of assistantships for graduate students wishing to study on a full-time basis towards the Masters of Science degree.

The assistantships are offered in conjunction with either part-time teaching or research work and full-time study and will cover the cost of the tuition up to two years continuous study or four semesters. They offer a salary allowance which includes the following: Dependent Educational Costs, Home Leave Allowance, Housing, Medical Insurance and Transportation allowance.
